Myra Christopher is the founding director of the Center for Practical Bioethics, serving as the center's President and CEO from its inception in 1985 through 2011, when she became the Kathleen M. Myra has received many awards for her work to improve care for those suffering from advanced illness and chronic pain, including the American Society for Bioethics + Humanities' Lifetime Achievement Award in Bioethics, the American Academy of Pain Medicine's Patient Advocacy Award, the American Academy of Pain Management's "Head Heart" Award, and the National Association of Attorneys General President's Award. In March 2015 was inducted into the Starr Women's Hall of Fame at UMKC.


## Resident Elections

Ruth Harris Bohan (1891–1981) was a painter and printmaker. She studied at the Kansas City Art Institute with Randall Davies and in Europe in the 1910s. She later taught art at the Barstow School. Her husband, Dr. Peter Bohan, was a professor of medicine at the University of Kansas School of Medicine from 1941 to 1945. The Ruth Bohan Teaching Fellowship at the University of Kansas recognizes excellence in teaching in the medical school.

Ruth Bohan was awarded the Gold Medal for Painting at the Midwestern Artists' Exhibitions of 1924, 1925, and 1927. Her work is in the collections of the Spencer Museum of Art and the Nelson-Atkins Museum of Art.

### Movie Classic with Robert Butler | Young Frankenstein Wednesday, October 24 2:00 p.m. | Westport Room


